ORDER

ON THIS DAY came on to be heard the Defendant's Motion to Examine Defendant for Competency. After hearing the evidence and arguments of counsel, the court finds that the motion should be GRANTED/~~DENIED~~.

The Court hereby ORDERS that Dr. Maureen Burrows M.D., a disinterested expert experienced and qualified in mental health or mental retardation to examine the defendant pursuant to Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Articles 46B.

The examiner is advised that the Defendant is charged with the felony offense of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon alleged to have been committed on or about November 4, 2017.

A person is incompetent to stand trial if he does not have (1) sufficient present ability to consult with his lawyer with a reasonable degree of rational understanding or (2) a rational as well as factual understanding of the proceedings against her.

The examiner shall submit a competency report in writing to this Court within 30 days of this Order of Examination. The report shall state the examining expert's opinion on the defendant's competency or incompetency to stand trial or explain why the expert is unable to state such an opinion. The report shall also identify and address specific issues referred to the expert for examination; document that the expert explained to the defendant the purpose of the evaluation, the persons to whom the report is provided, and the limits on rules of confidentiality applying to the relationship between the expert and defendant; in general terms, describe procedures, techniques and tests used in the examination and the purpose of each procedure, technique or test; and, the expert's clinical observations, findings, and opinions on each specific issue referred to the expert by the court, and state specifically on issues on which the expert could not provide an opinion.



If the expert concludes that the defendant is incompetent to stand trial, the report shall include 1) the exact nature of the deficits resulting from the defendant's mental illness or mental retardation, if any, that impact factors listed in Article 46B.024, contributing to the defendant's incompetency; and 2) prospective treatment options, if any, appropriate for the defendant.

The Williamson County Auditor shall pay the reasonable and necessary fees charged by said psychiatrist for the above examination and reports.
